We at Compass Home Dialysis want our patients, partners and friends to know that we are diligently monitoring COVID-19 and following the guidance and recommendations of the Centers for Disease Control, state and local Departments of Health and Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services to ensure the safety of our patients is never compromised as we continue to provide their life-sustaining dialysis treatments.

At this time we have activated a stringent COVID-19 pandemic protocol at our corporate office, treatment and training center and across all of our skilled nursing facility (SNF) programs. No family members or visitors may enter our facilities or visit with patients in our SNF programs during treatment at this time.
